### **Pete Waite—University of Wisconsin**

#### **Head Women's Volleyball Coach**

##### **COACHING HIGHLIGHTS**

- 2000, 2001, 2006 Big Ten Coach of the Year
- 2000 & 2001 Regional Coach of the Year
- Big Ten Conference Championships in 2000 & 2001
- Led the Badgers to the Final Four and a second place finish nationally in 2000
- UW's winningest coach with over 500 career victories
- Author of Aggressive Volleyball book for coaches and players.

### **Bond Shymansky—Marquette University**

#### **Head Women's Volleyball Coach**

Shymansky arrives in Milwaukee after serving for each of the previous seven seasons as head coach at Georgia Tech. Under his guidance, the Yellow Jackets made three NCAA Tournament appearances and garnered multiple team and individual accolades. Georgia Tech posted an overall record of 172-64 (.729) during his tenure, including a 96-38 mark in the Atlantic Coast Conference. In seven seasons, Shymansky led Georgia Tech to the NCAA Sweet 16 (2003), the NCAA Elite 8 (2004), ACC Tournament Championship (2002) and ACC Regular Season Championship (2003 and 2004). He was named the league's coach of the year in 2004 after guiding the program to a 27-7 overall record and a perfect 16-0 conference campaign. He was also the AVCA East Region Coach of the Year that season as well. Individually, eight student-athletes have claimed All-America honors under his tutelage and 10 different players have earned a total of 21 All-ACC selections. A pair of Yellow Jackets were tabbed the ACC Player of the Year during his tenure and four players earned spots on the ACC All Freshman Team. Prior to his arrival at Georgia Tech, Shymansky spent two seasons on the coaching staff at Iowa State and has coached in both the high school and club ranks. He served as the head coach at Iowa City High School from 1996-97, guiding his squad to the state semifinals in his second season. A native of Iowa City, Iowa, Shymansky began his volleyball career at the University of Iowa, where he was a member of the men's volleyball club as a setter and outside hitter from 1991-93. He earned his degree in communications in 1995 from Iowa before completing his master's degree in secondary English education in 1998. Shymansky, 36, is married to the former Catherine Cruikshank of Iowa City, Iowa. The couple has a 13-year old daughter, Corrina, and two sons, Nicholas, 10, and Bond, 2.

### **Tom Keating—Xavier High School**

Tom Keating has been involved with Catholic education for over 40 years as a student, a teacher, a coach, an athletic director, and now as principal at Xavier. Tom spent 24 of those years at Wahlert High School where he taught Psychology, coached volleyball and served as Athletic Director. This is his seventh year as principal at Xavier High School. Tom earned his B.A. in psychology at Simpson College and holds a Master's in Education Administration from Loras College. Tom has written several articles on coaching. He has written four graduate courses for Drake University on goal-setting, team-building, parent-coach relationships and coaching for success. He has taught graduate courses on teaching and coaching. He served this year as color commentator for the Iowa state volleyball championships. Tom's volleyball teams at Wahlert won 11 state championships. He was named National Volleyball Coach of the Year twice - in 2004 (Prepvolleyball.com) and 2005 (NFHS). He has been inducted into the Iowa Volleyball Coaches Hall of Fame and the National Association of Athletic Coaches Hall of Fame. He is a member of the Iowa Girls High School Athletic Union Hall of Fame selection committee. Last year he was elected to the Iowa High School Athletic Association's Board of Control. Recently the National Catholic Education Association named Tom one of six recipients of its "National Educator of the Year" award. He was the only principal selected. Tom and his wife Jodi have been married for 30 years. They have three sons, Kevin, Tim and Ryan. Tom lives by the belief that "we either get better or worse; we never stay the same."

## **WVCA 2010 COACHES' CLINIC PRESENTERS**

### **Chad Schreiber- Lakeland College**

#### **Head Women's Volleyball Coach and Head Men's Volleyball Coach**

Chad Schreiber just completed his 15<sup>th</sup> season at Lakeland College and won his 300<sup>th</sup> match with the women's program. This season the women won their 8<sup>th</sup> conference title in the last 9 seasons and advanced to their 6<sup>th</sup> NCAA tournament. The men's program at Lakeland competes at the collegiate club level and just played in their 3<sup>rd</sup> national championship match in the past 4 seasons...winning a national title in 2008. Schreiber is a 6-time women's conference coach of the year, men's national coach of the year, Go Fish Club Director, USA Volleyball Badger Region Treasurer, Badger Region Boy's High Performance Director, and former NCAA Division III Volleyball national chair.

### **Brian Schaefer—University of Wisconsin—Oshkosh**

#### **Head Women's Volleyball Coach and Head Men's Volleyball Coach**

Brian Schaefer was named the head women's coach at UW-Oshkosh in 2005 and has led the Titans to a 150-26 record. In Schaefer's short time the Titans have won three WIAC titles (2005, 2006 and 2008) and advanced to the NCAA Division III tournament in 2005, 2006, 2007 and 2008. He was named the 2005 and 2008 WIAC and Midwest Region Coach of the Year. Schaefer also has been the UW-Oshkosh men's collegiate club head since the 2001 season and has amassed a 451-134-5 record. The Titans have won seven consecutive Midwest Ten Conference titles and a total of seven Wisconsin Volleyball Conference crowns. In 2006 and 2007 UW-Oshkosh won the NCCS Division I national title and captured second-place in 2005 and 2009.

## RECOGNIZE PLAYER/TEAM ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENTS

The Wisconsin Volleyball Coaches' Association All-Academic Team is designed to honor high school varsity volleyball players who have proven excellence in the classroom. To be eligible to receive this award, players must have a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.5 on a 4.0 scale, or the equivalent on another scale, during the first semester of the school year. Only a player who has earned a varsity letter during the season according to her school's requirements is eligible for this award. (Notice this is the GPA for the first semester of the 2010-11 school year). Applications are due March 1, 2011.

The Wisconsin Volleyball Coaches' Association Team Academic Award is designed to honor high school varsity volleyball teams which have proven excellence in the classroom. To be eligible to receive this award, teams must have a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.3 on a 4.0 scale, or the equivalent on another scale, during the entire school year. This will include GPA's from all players who competed at the varsity level. (Notice this is the GPA for the entire 2010-2011 school year). Applications are due July 1, 2011.

### HOW TO NOMINATE PLAYER

Complete the registration form and send it along with your team's competition schedule. The head coach must be a WVCA member, go to <http://www.wvcawi.net/allstatenominationform.htm> for the nomination form.

All nominations must be received by **September 12, 2010**. Nomination lists and competition information are given to the evaluation committee immediately after the deadline so that they can begin the evaluation process.

### CRITERIA FOR ALL-STATE NOMINATIONS

- 1) The athlete is an impact player in every match played.
- 2) The athlete is one of the better players on the floor in every match played.
- 3) The athlete has superb technical skills in addition to outstanding athleticism.
- 4) The athlete typically plays, or is capable of playing, all six rotations (or is truly superior in a more limited capacity).
- 5) The athlete could potentially play Division I or II Collegiate Volleyball.
- 6) The athlete possesses and exhibits outstanding personal characteristics.
- 7) The athlete is in good standing and is not in violation of, nor being reviewed for violations of, any Athletic or School Code of Conduct.

We are proud to recognize those players who help to make our game special and memorable. The top 36 players in the State and all the seniors selected to honorable mention will be invited, along with their parents, to attend a banquet in their honor on the afternoon of Sunday, November 28<sup>th</sup>, 2010, in the Wisconsin Dells area. Therefore, if you nominate a player you should ask them to try to keep that afternoon free. And if they are selected we ask that you encourage them to attend the banquet. As the coach of a player so honored you are also invited to attend the banquet.

Please, complete a separate nomination form for every exceptionally good player in your program. Please send in the nomination form and a copy of your teams' competition schedule by the deadline of September 12, 2010. The deadline is early so that the evaluation committee can get out and observe the players nominated. You are encouraged to nominate any and every player who may be deserving of such recognition. Late nominations will not be accepted under any circumstances.
